Beef (Market Steers)


Market steers at the fair range in weight from approx. 1000 to 1500 pounds. The large weight range in market steers is mainly due to the different breeds of animals.

Based on the average price of \$1.95 per pound, and the average weight of 1248 lbs., this steer would cost a total of \$2,434 at the fair. (See 2017 SCF Sale Information below)

A 1300 pound market steer will provide almost 600 pounds of meat for your family. The average cost to process this animal is \$520.

Too much meat for just your family? Get together with another family and purchase ½ a beef animal.


Pork / Pigs (Market Hogs)

Market hogs at the fair range in weight from 210 to 290 pounds.

Based on the average price of \$2.59 per pound, and the average weight of 244 lbs., this hog would cost a total of \$632 at the fair. (See 2017 SCF Sale Information below)

A 250-pound market hog will provide almost 125 pounds of meat for your family. The average cost to process this animal is \$130.


Sheep (Market Lambs)

Market lambs at the fair range in weight from 90 to 150 pounds.

Based on the average price of \$3.27 per pound, and the average weight of 120 lbs., this lamb would cost a total of \$392 at the fair. (See 2017 SCF Sale Information below)

A 120-pound lamb will provide almost 64 pounds of meat for your family. The average cost to process this animal is \$74.

Goats (Market Goats)

Goat cuts are the same as the market lamb cuts in the diagram above. Market goats are sold by the head, and not by the pound.

A 70 pound market goat will provide your family with 31 pounds of meat. The average cost to process this animal is \$74.
